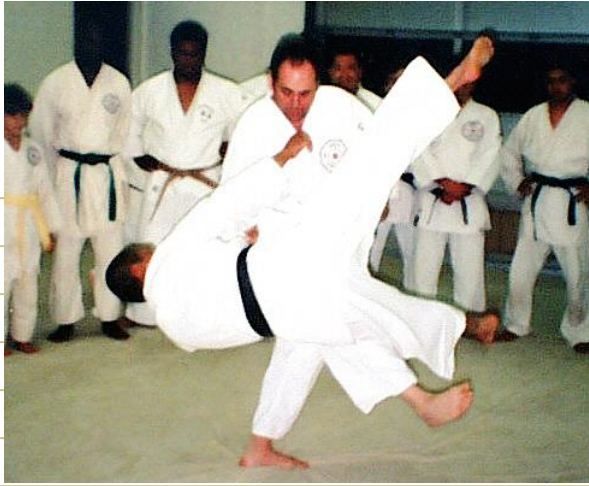
Our Route 66 Trek

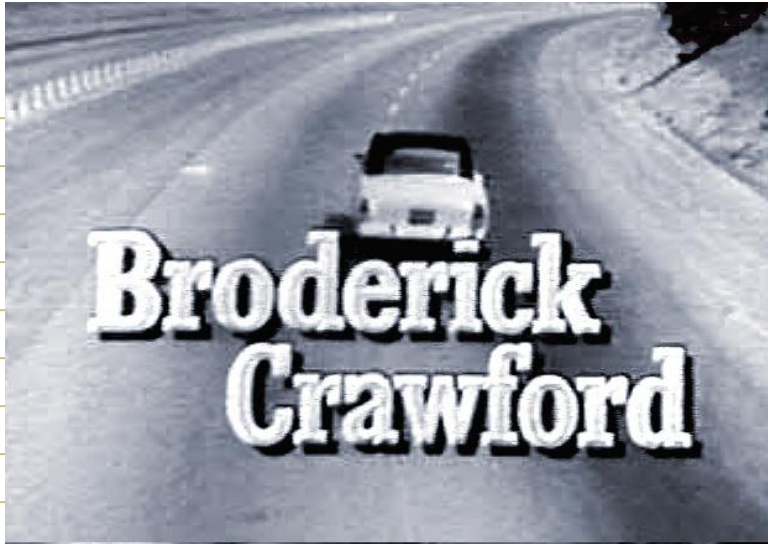

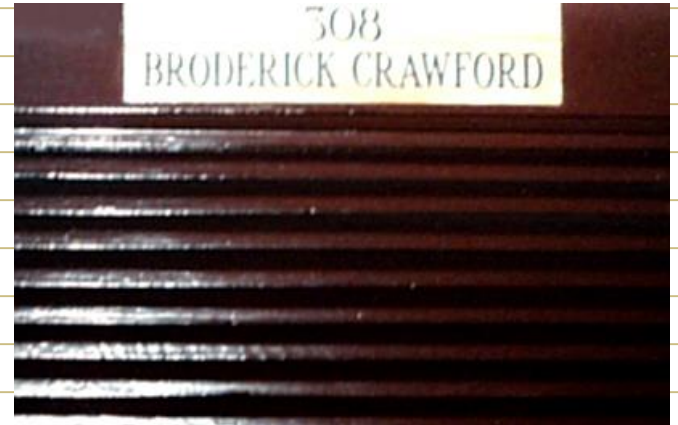

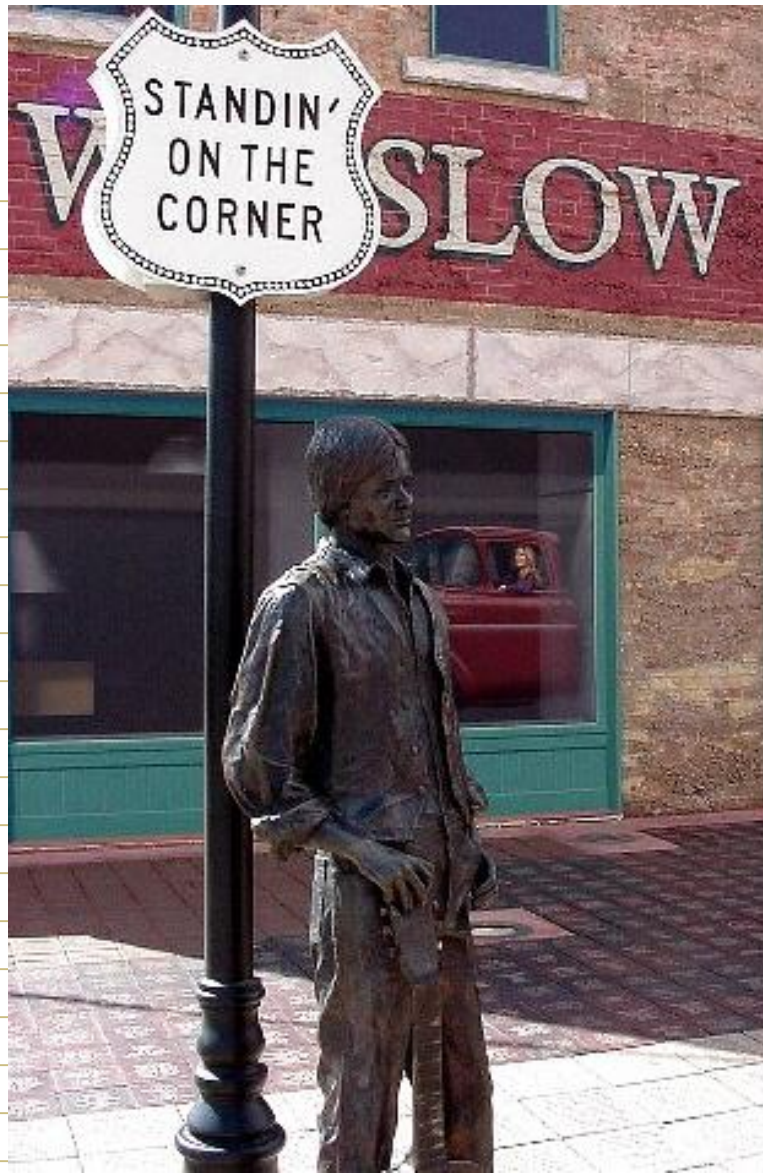
